Councillor Davis requested a list of Key Business Applications for January's meeting. He also raised concern that the Council could be running various old systems behind the latest versions. He asked are we paying for everything we ran and are we going to have an unexpected unplanned bill for maintenance/software for equipment we are still running? The question would be asked of the ICT Manager and the reply would be circulated and published.

To help understand and answer the questions and concerns posed I have broken them out in to a separate list shown below.

Q1. A list of key business applications

A1. A list of key business applications is included below in appendix 1

Concern 1. Concern we are running various old systems.

Answer Concern 1. We have a plan we are implementing to upgrade the standard office systems used by all staff and this will be delivering a new desktop shortly.

Q2. Are we paying for everything we run?

A2. Yes. It should be noted we have some in-house developed products which may be developed further or replaced by an alternative commercial product at an appropriate time. All 3rd party line of business software applications are under supplier maintenance agreements.

Q3. Are we going to have any un-expected bills?

A3. No and possibly yes. It should be noted support for both windows 7 and 2008 r2 is being discontinued in January 2020. This means ICT will be engaged in projects migrating major applications from older server platforms to newer server platforms. In some cases this will incur consultancy costs from suppliers which we are unknown at this point in time, so some estimated costs will be included in the next Opex (operational expenditure) budget proposal. Additionally it is difficult to predict exact Opex costs for the next financial year because of external factors such as currency fluctuations because all IT is priced in US Dollars.
