Councillor Norman Kay	Committee
Given the unfairness of including the receipt of disability benefit payments in the calculation of Discretionary Housing Payments, will the committee agree to investigate and report back to committee on a policy of ignoring these payments in future? Such a report to include any views of the CAB on the effects.	When deciding how to treat income from disability-related benefits such as Disability Living Allowance or the Personal Independence Payment, we have regard to the decision of the High Court in R v. Sandwell MBC, ex parte Hardy. In particular, we consider each DHP claim on a case by case basis having regard to the purpose of those benefits and whether the money from those benefits has been committed to other liabilities associated with disability. DWP provide a Discretionary Housing Payments Guidance Manual which includes a good practice guide. We work towards that guidance as mentioned in the policy.
	Officers have spent a significant amount of time working with members and CAB on the DHP policy. There has already been a members awareness evening, 2 information' sheets during 2016 and a task and finish group. DHP has increased for 2016/17, with £108,374 spend against a budget of £117,588.
Supplementary Question: Councillor Kay wanted assurance that this would be investigated by the Chair, Councillor Steve Robinson.	It was agreed that a further member review of DHP policy would be undertaken by Councillor Jonathan Edmunds and Councillor Penny Wride.
