To set up an informal round table discussion group to progress strategy around CN2030 on a cross party basis with members to be nominated by each political group.</li> <li>2. To authorise the Interim Head of Legal Services &amp; Monitoring Officer to affix the common seal to new Byelaws for the regulation of businesses that carry out acupuncture, tattooing cosmetic piercing, semi-permanent skin-colouring, and electrolysis and carry out the necessary procedure and apply to the Secretary of State for confirmation.</li> <li>3. Subject to the confirmation of the proposed new Byelaws, take such steps necessary to revoke the Council's existing Byelaws relating to acupuncture, tattooing, ear piercing and electrolysis that came into force on 1<sup>st</sup> August 1986.</li> </ol>
