#### 1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Council is required by the Local Government & Housing Act 1989 to review the political balance on its committees on an annual basis and then in any circumstances set out in Regulations under the 1989 Act. Political balance should also be recalculated following changes to the membership of political groups.
- 1.2 Committee Memberships were last agreed at the Council Meetings on the 18 May 2023 and 20 July 2023.
- 1.3 Due to the change to the political group numbers following Councillor Jessie Hoskin's decision to step down from the Labour Group and join the Independent Left Group the political balance has been recalculated.
- 1.4 The changes to political balance and nominations for committees will be reported in Appendix A or otherwise made at the Council Meeting. Appendix A will be circulated prior to the Council Meeting on the 26 October 2023.
