December 15th 2023 - Cost of Living Working Group – Stroud District Foodbank

As agreed by the Cost of Living (CoL) Working Group, these monthly briefings will now focus on a single topic.

This month's topic is an update about Stroud District Foodbank. Amanda Strover, Stroud District Foodbank Manager had intended to join us on the 15th December but unfortunately had to cancel due to the pressures of demand at the Foodbank. The number of parcels they have distributed so far in December has gone up more than 100%, compared to the same period last year.

Increased Outreach Foodbank Sessions

The Foodbank are working closely with the Community Hubs to deliver outreach sessions and have increased their locations across the District this year as new Hubs have developed. See timetable below.

Foodbank and Advice Partnerships

The Foodbank is working in partnership with Citizens Advice and P3 to host their advice workers during outreach Foodbank sessions. Seeing clients for 1:1 advice appointments in outreach venues is a great advantage for Hubs and clients. The Hubs know they can encourage clients to visit during a weekly Foodbank session and they will get the advice they need. Some of this extra advice resource has been funded by the Trussel Trust and some has been funded from the Household Support Fund in response to the Cost of Living crisis.

Foodbank Usage Statistics and Opening Hours for Christmas 2023

The Foodbank staff and volunteers are under a lot of pressure right now. It is hamper season and they also have a huge increase in referrals, over 900 emergency parcels so far this month (1st-14th Dec). They did 439 for the same period last year.

Christmas 2023 Hours - Due the pressure of the winter period, the Stroud District Foodbank have a policy of giving their staff and volunteers time off between Christmas and New Year. This year the Foodbank will be closing on Friday 22nd December. Referrals need to be with them no later than 11am that day. They are closed 25th & 26th Dec and will be open for
