The board last met on 8 July but has a meeting scheduled for 16 September, the day of the CSL meeting, so I will be able to update members at the committee meeting as to the latest situation in the district and across Gloucestershire. Members will no doubt be aware that cases over the summer have been high across the Southwest region, contributed to by visitors and festivals, which had caused central government as well as local leaders in Devon and Cornwall some concern, although in recent days there has been a decline in cases in the region although the impact of children returning to school may make a difference.

For the last week of August, Stroud District had the highest cases in the county, at 431, a rate of 359.3 per 100,000. This is roughly about double the cases we had in July.
