Prior to the meeting, I was invited to visit the Mansion and I was pleased to be shown around, which included parts of the building not normally open t the public.

I was welcomed to my first meeting by the Chair of the Trustees, Rhiannon Wigzell.

During the lockdown the Trust had lost £140,000 in revenue. They hope to be able to survive though to next spring.

Improvements are needed in the shop, advertising, signage and social media.

The café is not being run by the Nelson Trust, which they are generally working more closely with.

I suggested that they invite Kevin Ward from The Museum in the Park to visit the Mansion. The Trustees would welcome visits from any councillors.

The Mansion currently does not offer any guided tours to visits with sight impairment. I am pleased to be able to have them in touch with the person who has organised this type of service at Westonbirt.

I have since heard from Rhiannon that the Trustees will in future ask me to attend meetings quarterly.
