## **BRIEF REPORT**

There have been no meetings of the Gloucestershire Police and Crime panel since the last report.

Future meetings: There is a presentation by the Commissioner's Office on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> January to present the draft budget for 2023/4.

There is a second meeting at the Subscription rooms in Stroud on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> January at 6.30pm on the subject of attacks on women by men when the Commissioner, Police officers, other experts and representatives from schools and colleges will attend and be on a panel to update residents on action taken since the first meeting in August and take questions. The later in response to concerns about the role schools have in educating boys on their behaviours with women.

Connected with the above meeting an independent evaluation of the Government's Safer Streets funding shows it is leading to growing confidence and engagement with the police, and that the £3m secured since January 2020 has been used to prevent and address issues in areas including male violence against women and girls, neighbourhood crime and anti-social behaviour.
