

### Allocations to Committees & Political Balance

1.1 Following the Painswick and Upton District Ward By-Election on Wednesday 17 May 2023, Councillor Gary Luff, the Green Party Candidate, was elected. This has resulted in an additional Councillor for the Green Group taking the total to 14.

1.2 The seats on each committee must be allocated to each political group as required by the Local Government and Housing Act 1989. On the basis of the existing committee structure, the allocations are as set out below:
