	<ul> <li>stating that the Council believes there is an urgent need for the registration and control of the increasing trend towards the offering of Air B&amp;B's,</li> <li>requesting that all possible measures are taken to ensure that relevant Health and Safety requirements under the current national regulations for Health and Safety are in place, including but not limited to all relevant electrical and gas checks, fire escape requirements etc, as apply to all registered landlords are applied to Air B&amp;B's; and</li> <li>confirming that Stroud District Council will fully support any legislation for mandatory registration of such properties.</li> </ul>
Context for the motion (i.e. why is the motion being submitted – what is the proposer aiming to achieve)	It seems that the growth of Air B&B continues unabated, this has some serious concerns with it. It appears that more buy to let owners have taken to letting out their properties in areas that attract tourism particularly, to this form of income source. The results are that less homes are available for long term lets, even though the need for this type of property is growing at a high rate. An example of this issue is here with us in Painswick, where there are now apparently 54 Air B&B's being offered.  Another concern is that there appears to be little if any regulation for the practice, which could lead to serious safety concerns. There is no registration scheme for these properties and therefore as such no control of the measures to ensure the safety of the hirers is in place.
